### Reconfirmation Meeting for November

<b>Reconfirm instructional delivery method:</b>
DK - 12 Hybrid and Virtual Academy
<b>Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:</b>
<u>Elementary (DK - 1st Grade):</u> Students will have the option to attend school 4 days per week for face-to-face instruction with the other day's instruction occurring virtually (Hybrid Model) OR attend the virtual academy.  For in-person instruction, students and staff health and safety will be addressed through a cohort model that keeps students together for the entire day.
<u>Elementary (Grades 2nd - 5th):</u> Students will have the option to attend school 2 days per week for face-to-face instruction with the other days' instruction occurring virtually (Hybrid Model) OR attend the virtual academy.  For in-person instruction, students and staff health and safety will be addressed through a cohort model that keeps students together for the entire day.  Considered Changes: Virtual Learning
<u>Middle School (Grades 6th - 8th):</u> Students will have the option to attend school alternating between 2 & 3 days per week for face-to-face instruction with the other day's instruction occurring virtually (Hybrid Model) OR attend the virtual academy.

For in-person instruction, students and staff health and safety will be addressed through a cohort model that keeps students together for the entire day. In the Cohort Model, students will learn through a variety of methods utilizing digital content and instruction.

Considered Changes: Adding every-other Wednesday in-person, at-risk students more, clubs/arts outside of school hours.

High School (Grades 9th - 12th):

Students will have the option to attend school alternating between 2 & 3 days per week for face-to-face instruction with the other days' instruction occurring virtually (Hybrid Model) OR attend the virtual academy. Beginning on Oct 24,

For in-person instruction, students and staff health and safety will be addressed through a cohort model that keeps students together for the entire day with minimal exceptions. In the Cohort Model, students will learn through a variety of methods utilizing digital content and instruction.

Considered Changes: Virtual Learning

**Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:**

The District is offering the same levels of in-person instruction for students considered special populations as those receiving general education in-person instruction.
